Painting Instructions for 4084 Oak Angel

Kimble Colors Needed: 951 Navajo, 931 Med. Yellow, 909 Gentle Flesh, 907 Caramel, 906 Cocoa Brown, 925 Med. Blue, 920 Moss Green, 914 Blush, 702 Walnut, 763 Antique Media

Kimble Drybrush Kit, detail brushes, Soft Paper Towel

Basecoat the bisque with 951 Navajo. Use a large stiff drybrush to drybrush (heavily) the dress with 931 Medium Yellow. Clean up the branch on the skirt by repainting it 951 Navajo using a small brush. Using small drybrushes, drybrush each of these areas with these colors: the flesh - 909 Gentle Flesh, hair-907 Caramel, tree branch & Nest-906 Cocoa Brown, Bird & Eggs-925 Medium Blue. Drybrush the outer portion of the leaf/wings 920 Moss Green. Drybrush a little 914 Blush on the cheeks of the angel and the bird. Paint the peak 914 Blush. Allow the piece to dry completely. Working in small areas, antique the entire piece with 702 Walnut. Wipe the Walnut back using a soft paper towel and 763 Antique Media. Leave more Walnut on the lower portion of the dress to accent the whittle marks. If necessary, re-drybrush the face with Gentle flesh and Blush and the top of the dress with 931 Medium Yellow.
