Painting Instructions for
4088 Planted Rock

750 Bisque Primer, 717 Mushroom, 763 Antique Media, 714 Teal, 715 Burgundy, 709 topaz, 707 Evergreen, 706 Tangerine, 713 Primrose, 710 Sunshine, 700 White, 702 Walnut, 761 Perfect Matte Spray, 972 Silver

Kimple IT Brush Kit

Soft Paper Towel

Use a large soft brush to basecoat the bisque with 750 Bisque Primer. Working in small areas apply and 717 Mushroom with a large brush and wipe back 717 Mushroom with a soft paper towel moistened with 763 Antique Media. Use a large natural hair filbert brush just slightly tipped in the color product to apply 714 Teal, 715 Burgundy and 709 Topaz independently to random areas of the rock. Blend the colors using a soft paper towel, Antique Media and clean brushes. Use a small natural hair filbert to apply 707 Evergreen to the leaves and pat back with clean paper towel or clean brush. Use a small brush to apply 706 Tangerine to the tops of the mushrooms and 717 to the stems. Pat back to desired intensity. Use a clean dry natural hair filbert to apply a very small amount of 713 Primrose to the lower portion of the mushroom caps, blending into the Tangerine. Use the same technique to highlight the top of the mushroom cap with 710 Sunshine. Apply and pat back 707 mixed with 717 Mushroom to the lichen on the side of the rock. Highlight the lichen with 709 Topaz and 714 Teal. Use a small brush to apply and pat back 714 Teal mixed with 700 White. Apply and pat back 714 Teal snail body. Apply and pat back 702 Walnut to the snail shell. Allow the colors to dry completely. Spray with 761 Perfect Matte Spray. If desired drybrush a little 972 Silver on the snail shell and dragonfly.
